Amendment to Ordinance #60

An Ordinance regulating animals within the city of Lismore, keeping and impounding animals, necessary basic care of animals and penalties for violations thereof.

Section 13: Basic Care shall be amended to read:

All animals shall receive from their owners or keepers kind and humane treatment. This includes but is not limited to adequate housing, any dog or cat kept outside the property owners' house for more than an hour at a time shall be required to have an insulated dog house of adequate size to accommodate the growing size of the dog or cat. Any animal kept outside for any length of time is required to have sufficient food and water at all times. Food and water are required to be put in a spill proof container and secured if necessary to prevent chewing or tipping over. All animals kept outside are required to be in a kennel or secured on a leash or cable long enough to allow them to protect themselves from harsh weather elements, including snow, rain, and hail or summer heat. Any person not treating their pet in a humane manner will be subject to the penalties and fines set forth in Section 18 of this ordinance.
